6. GIS Discussion / Data Issues

David Wheelock discussed with the Council members the issue of 10-meter digital elevation models. David has learned that the 10-meter DEM data available in Oklahoma is not true 10-meter data. It is 30-meter data that has been resampled to 10 meter. True 10 meter can be developed if funds are found to create this data. Discussion among the members of the Council and audience was held on this issue.

Mary Banken discussed her ongoing conversations with people involved with the 2010 census. She requested that if anyone in Oklahoma is currently working with census related issues or someone has been contacting you about those issues, please let her know so she can be more aware of the Oklahoma activities.

Mike Sughru discussed the status of the job description request with Office of Personnel Management. This request is on hold for now but work still needs to be done to get the job descriptions defined.

Mike Sharp mentioned the need for better centerline data for the State.

7. New Business

Information about the budget request for the Office of Geographic Information was placed in the packets of the Council members. This request is to fund the new State Coordinator position. Discussion about this item was held among the group.

Mike Sharp announced that GIS Day at the Capitol was once again a successful event with a great turnout.

Ray Fox, USGS, mentioned that the Inter Tribal Indigenous Mapping Conference was held in Tulsa in early March. Tribes from all over the country was in attendance. Ray stated it was a great way to make contacts and an event the Council might want to attend next year.

David Lowther mentioned that SCI would be the participating in the National Map project. SCI will be the first private partner in the region.

Mary Banken discussed the upcoming MAGIC conference in April 2006

Shellie Willoughby announced the OK South Central Arc Users Group (SCAUG) Conference would be held Thursday, October 6. She also announced that OK SCAUG would be hosting 3 user group meetings this year. Details will be sent out in the coming weeks.
