MINUTES State Geographic Information Council Meeting

4. Approval of April Meeting Minutes

5. Discussion and possible approval of the Job Classifications developed for OPM

Mike Sughru updated the Council members on the job description workgroup. Questions concerning the job descriptions were discussed and addressed. Council members were urged to prepare a letter to OPM supporting these new job descriptions. Letters are to be submitted to Mike Sughru to be included in the material sent to OPM. Jay Adams made a motion to adopt the job descriptions. Mark Gregory seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

6. <u>Discussion and possible approval of an updated National Spatial Data Infrastructure Partnership</u> <u>Agreement between the USGS National Geospatial Program Office and the Oklahoma State</u> <u>Geographic Information Council for the purpose of supporting the development and</u> <u>implementation of the Oklahoma Spatial Data Infrastructure and the National Spatial Data</u> <u>Infrastructure.</u> Mike Sharp discussed the details of the agreement with the Council members. Wade Patterson made a motion to approve the agreement with USGS. Jay Adams seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

7. <u>Discussion of the National States Geographic Council's initiative "Imagery for the Nation" and</u> possible approval of an endorsement of this initiative.

Mike Sharp discussed the Imagery for the Nation initiative. NSGIC is requesting a letter of support from each state supporting the initiative. Jay Adams made a motion to support the Imagery for the Nation initiative. Trish Weedn seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

8. <u>Discussion on need for new statewide aerial photography and request for funding from the Legislature.</u> Possible vote on making a request of the Legislature to allocate funding for acquiring statewide imagery.

Mike Sharp discussed the possibly of a statewide aerial photography project. The project would be a leaf off color 2 foot resolution. Mike would like to ask Legislature for half the money for the project and raise the rest of the money from other sources. Questions concerning the project were addressed. Jay Adams made a motion to move forward with a legislative request for funding. Wade Patterson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

9. Discussion on future Council initiatives and workgroups

Jay Adams discussed the joint ODOT USGS DEM project with the group. The project will complete the 10 meter DEM's for the state. The data is scheduled to be released in early 2008.

Mike Sharp discussed the National Hydrography Dataset (NHD). A one day NHD Stewardship meeting will be held soon. The meeting will be for anyone who is interested in using and maintaining the data. More details will be sent out as they become available.
