

The "GIO"

- Oversee all Garrison Installation Geospatial Information and Services (IGI&S) activities
- Identify Requirements and report to IMCOM W
- Integrate development and use of Garrison IGI&S date and systems within the Garrison to the maximum benefit to the Army
- Identify and Provide appropriate source data for development of data
- Organize Garrison IGI&S activities





Actions Taken to Make GIS better at Fort Sill

- To allow the Garrison to function and make strategic planning decisions
- Maintain and update the SDE Server and 400+ features
- Participate in Army Environmental Command data collection taskers for Army Mapper
- Incorporate Active Duty Units with GIS capability in the Garrison GIS Users Group
- Collaboration with the City of Lawton and Cameron University
- Data exchange with sister agencies and other interested parties






Benefits of IGI&S

- Visualization


















Army Mapper Benefits

- Funded by ACSIM (Asst Chief of Staff Installation Mangt)
 - GIS capability for Army community at low to no cost
 - Centrally funded and managed hardware and software
 - Create and edit GIS and CADD data
 - Provide basic map capability (like "Map Quest")
- Fort Sills participation
- Central system accreditation and certification
- Security provided (AKO and CAC)
- Data backed up and archived
- Data standardized
- Shared tools
- End User
 - PT paths
