4. Approval of February Meeting Minutes

5. <u>Committee Reports</u>

Shellie Willoughby stated that little progress has been made on the GIS Job Descriptions. She is still working with OPM in order to get the issues resolved and get the descriptions implemented soon.

Dan Hough gave the Council members a landcover dataset workgroup update. The group applied for funds from US Fish and Wildlife to complete a pilot project. The pilot project will focus on the Panhandle and needs to be completed by September 30. The awardees for the funds have yet to be announced. The group is planning to meet soon to continue working on a plan to complete the landcover dataset for the entire state.

6. Presentation: GISP Certification in Oklahoma, Sheila Wilson, GIS Certification Institute

7. GIS Discussion / Data Issues

Mike proposed that the Council members be prepared to have a discussion concerning the possibility of approving an endorsement of the GISP certification at the next meeting.

Mike stated that US Forestry Service provided the funding required by USDA-FSA to acquire the CIR band with the natural color bands in the 1-meter, leaf-on NAIP photography that is being flown this summer. The data will be available in two formats: natural color compressed county mosaics (CCMs) and uncompressed 4 band natural color plus CIR DOQQ's. When the 4-band DOQQ's become available, perhaps this fall, the Office of Geographic Information plans to acquire them and create 4-band CCMs.

Amy Brittain of DEQ would like to start an environmental workgroup to discuss water layer data issues for the state. The group will discuss data layers such as the WBID dataset. If you are interested in participating contact Amy Brittain at <u>Amy.Brittain@deq.ok.gov</u>

Cliff Broadworth mentioned that the Dept of Libraries now has a shapefile of all the libraries in the state. He plans to get that dataset to OU Center for Spatial Analysis for download soon.
