5% Areas
Effective June 1, 2017 - May 31, 2018
Most businesses that qualify for the [Quality Jobs Program](#) receive payments in the range of 4% of new payroll. In certain counties designated as economically challenged, a 5% net benefit rate automatically applies. This percentage fluctuates by the average weighted salary of the new jobs.

Enterprise Zones
Effective July 1, 2017 - June 30, 2018
The [Investment/New Jobs Tax Credit Package](#) doubles in Enterprise Zones.

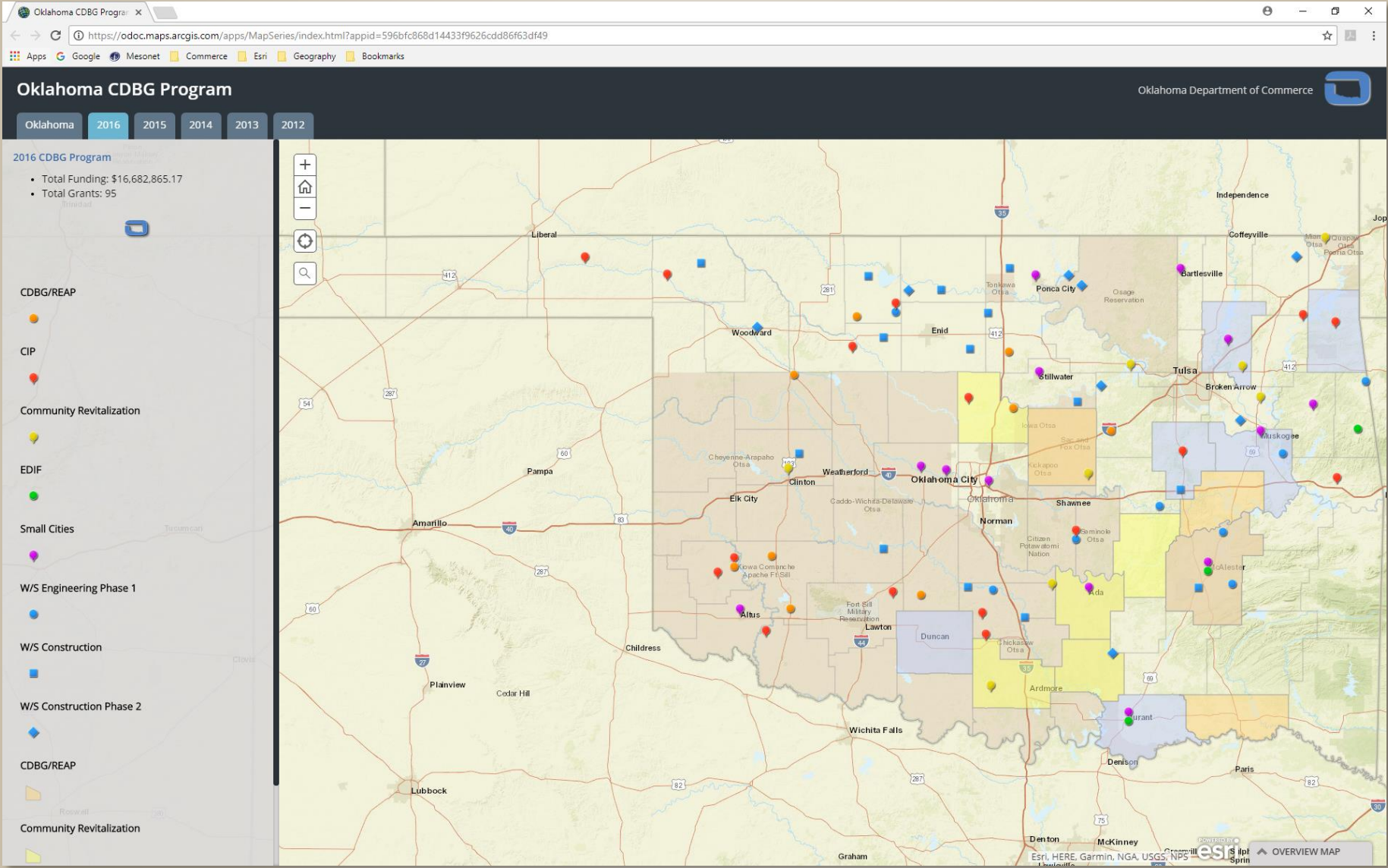

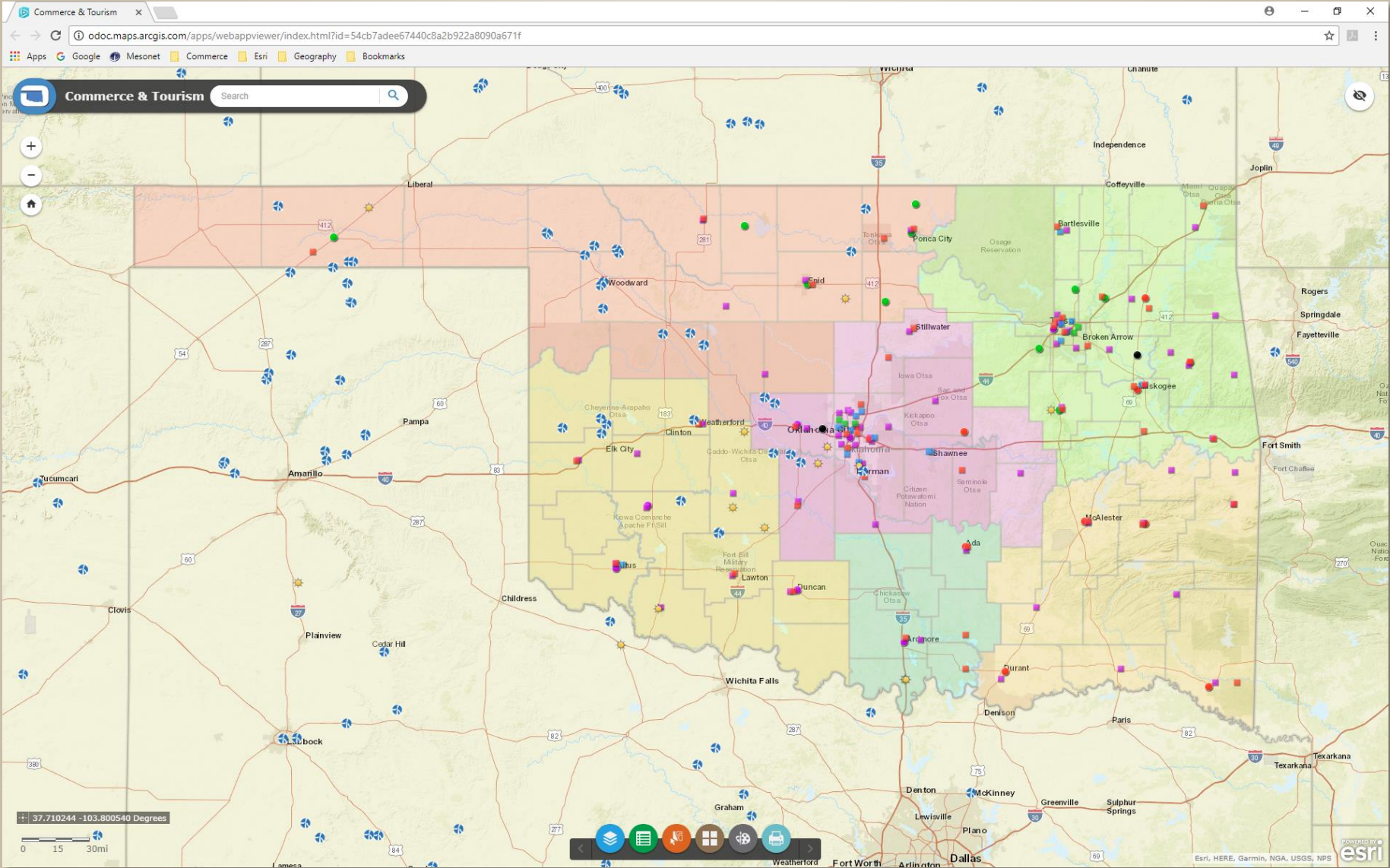


